Note: (5) Four Awards are available for both 'For Profit' and 'Not for Profit' nominees in each category. Select within the Online form as to which category the nominee fits.

AWARD SPONSOR	AWARD DESCRIPTION
Dena'ina Award For Profit & Not For Profit	Presented to a team/group for their: Outstanding leadership, professional excellence, and contributions to Downtown Anchorage
Chugach Mountain Award For Profit & Not For Profit	Presented to an employee in an organization or business that has demonstrated: Outstanding customer service skills and Professional excellence
Spirit of Alaska Award For Profit & Not For Profit	Presented to a volunteer who has demonstrated exceptional efforts to: Support a Downtown business, charity, or organization.
George M. Sullivan Award For Profit & Not For Profit	Presented to a leader, director or owner who: • Demonstrates strong leadership qualities who works well with a team.
Cook Inlet Award For Profit & Not For Profit	Presented to a manager or mid-level employee whose: Passion, talent and expertise makes the greatest contributions to their business/ organization
Ship Creek Landing Award (Only 1 award)	Presented to entrepreneur(s) who: • Started a new, innovative downtown business (in the last 3 years) that has enlivened downtown.
Captain James Cook Award S = small business (5,000 square feet & under) L = large business (More than 5,000 square feet)	Acknowledges outstanding design and/or construction on a new or remodeled exterior/ interior renovation or storefront of a business (in the last 3 years). *Must include additional information attached in support packet noted below under #3.*

Information Needed For HOA Award Submittal Online:

Must submit the following MINIMUM requirements and not exceed maximum requirements:

- CORRECT SPELLING/TITLING of nominee's name (person, business or organization)
- Narrative about the Nominee and why they are deserving of the specific award nomination (please share their "story" with us)
- Letters of support Minimum of 1 paragraph and no more than 1 page in length (Recommended sources: coworkers, board members, affiliated businesses, etc.)
- Additional pieces of support such as newspaper articles, magazine articles, photos, other community recognition pieces, etc. (Optional, but helps round out the nomination with at least 1 of the above)

[3] In addition to the above, any Captain James Cook Award Submissions MUST ALSO Include:

- Category of submittal: Small Business (5,000 sf & Under) or Large Business (More than 5,000 sf)
- Project Description/Narrative
- Interior Renovation, Exterior work or Both
- Renovation or New Construction
- Official Square Footage of Project
- Name of Owner/Occupant
- Name(s) of Design & Construction Firms
- Before AND after photos (Minimum of 4 photos and maximum of 12 photos)
