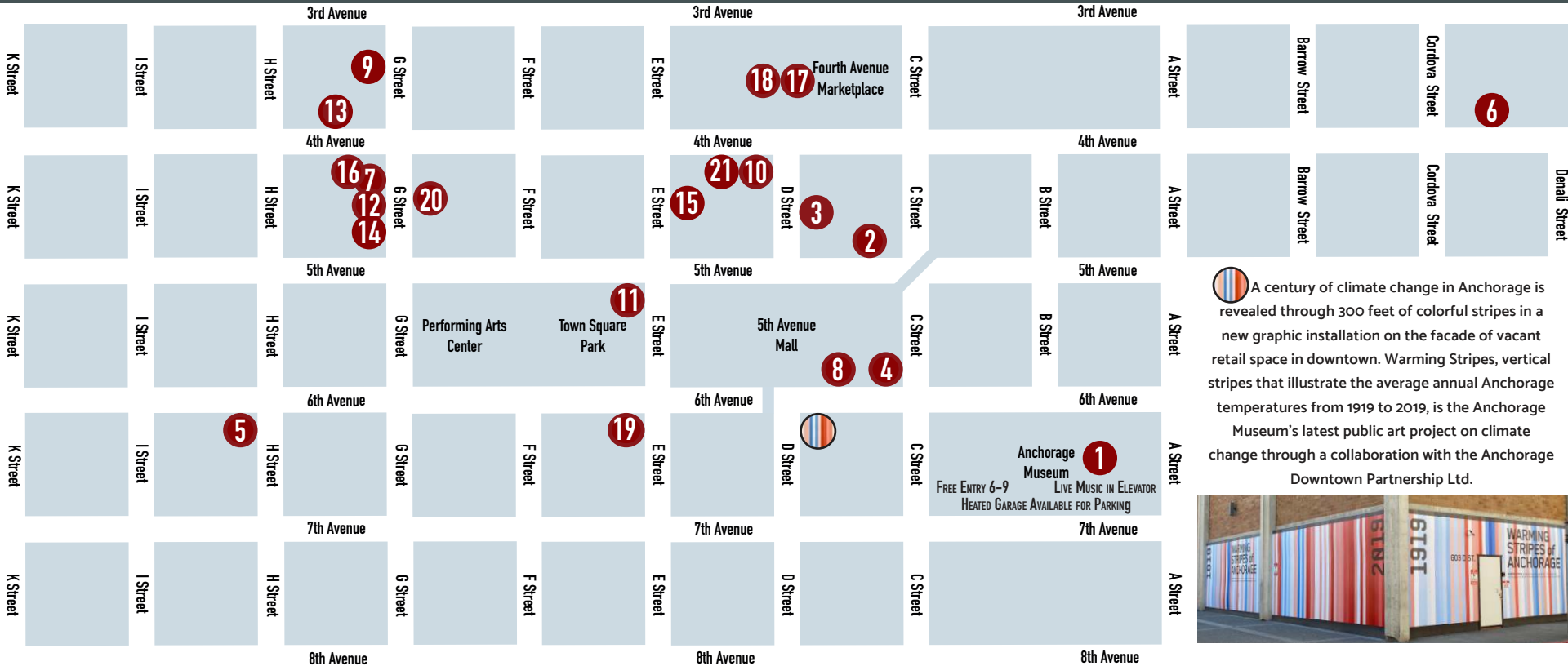



# June Window Art Walk



 A century of climate change in Anchorage is revealed through 300 feet of colorful stripes in a new graphic installation on the facade of vacant retail space in downtown.
