Arctic Melt

- Melts down to -5° F
- Environmentally friendly, non-toxic, and safe.

Contains:

- Sodium Chloride
- Potassium Chloride
- Magnesium Chloride
- Calcium Chloride



R.V. Antifreeze

- If you see a pink stain on the sidewalk, this is what we use to remove ice.
- We use it sparingly to reduce cost to you!
- Non-toxic to animals and people.

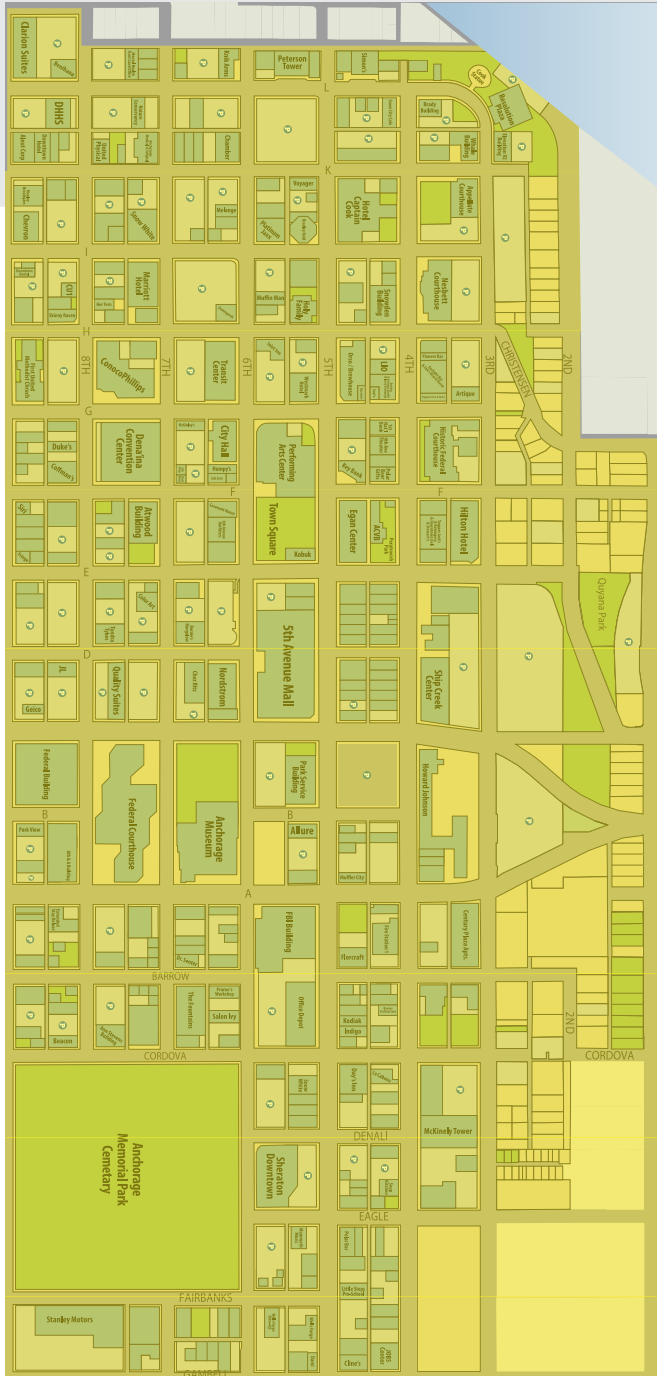
DOWNTOWN ANCHORAGE PHILOSOPHY

We're not just clearing snow and melting ice; we are providing services for people's safety.

Snow removal from sidewalks is a major responsibility. Downtown residents and visitors expect a safe environment and are not willing to tolerate inconveniences. At the same time, we all are challenged with limited budgets and negative impacts of the materials used in snow removal. ADP relies on a cooperative effort with all residents, business/property owners, and the Municipality of Anchorage in order to keep Downtown Anchorage sidewalks clean and safe.

SNOW REMOVAL SCHEDULE & MAP

The below map showcases the 123 blocks (over 26 linear miles) of sidewalks in the Downtown Improvement District (DID) that ADP keeps free of snow and ice! Sidewalks within the yellow boundaries on the map are within our snow removal service area.



MUNICIPAL CODE ON SNOW REMOVAL IN ANCHORAGE

Anchorage Municipal Code 24.80.090 states:

“it is the property owner’s responsibility to keep the right of way area adjacent to their property free of snow and ice ” and “an occupant of land... which is adjacent to a public sidewalk shall be responsible for the removal of any accumulation of snow and the removal or treatment of any ice that may accumulate, form or be deposited thereon.”

ADP’S SNOW REMOVAL DUTY TO DOWNTOWN ANCHORAGE

ADP snow removal teams start their work at 5:00am each day, 7 days per week.

- 1. First Pass** - Our team aims to complete their first pass through downtown prior to most businesses opening and workers arriving.
- 2. Second Pass** - Our teams aim to complete their second pass – *covering areas that require extra attention, secondary streets, and clean up along first pass routes* – before the end of the first day.
- 3. Lastly** - Contract Services follow all daily routes to complete snow and ice removal & sweeping services on a daily basis!



DISCLAIMER

Please remember snow removal takes time. We ask for your patience and flexibility! ADP is responsible for clearing snow and ice on over 123 blocks of sidewalk. We rely on a cooperative effort between residents, business/property owners, and the Municipality of Anchorage in order to keep downtown sidewalks clean and safe.
